

# IB ART CAMP

A two-week art immersion experience in Italy, July 1-14



An inspiring and stimulating summer camp for students aged 16 to 18 who are interested in making art in a new and exciting context, and in developing their potential as artists. The camp provides a focused learning experience in a supportive, creative environment where the student is encouraged to build upon their existing strengths and discover new ones. Each student is individually supported in the development of their artwork and investigation workbook while benefitting from the exchange of ideas within the small group dynamic.



- **Develop and refine skills as a visual artist**
- **Use inquiry to initiate and direct art work**
- **Develop an idea from a seed to a studio piece**
- **Encourage the relationship between investigation and art work**
- **Make new friendships with art students from different backgrounds**



The course is led by Heather McReynolds, an experienced IB Art teacher, examiner, author, and visual artist, with support from visiting tutors. The setting is La Vigna Art Studios, an artist residency and creative retreat centre in the beautiful Tuscan hills, between Pisa and Lucca.

The inclusive fee is **Euro 2,850**. This includes all tuition, art materials, accommodation in a farm guesthouse, delicious food, excursions to Florence or Lucca, and a day at the beach. Students must purchase their own travel insurance. An extra 3 day trip to Venice to visit the spectacular Biennale d'Arte can be added for an additional fee. There are only 10 places available, so we recommend that you apply early. To secure your booking, we will require a deposit of **Euro 600** per student by **31st March**. The balance should be paid by **31st May**.
